Activity outline / Amlinell gweithgaredd

- Laminate the printed copies of Teddy and the clothes
- Cut around the shapes leaving a small border so that the laminate stays sealed (don't cut around Teddy, as it is better as an A4 size)
- Arrange the clothes on a surface with the picture of Teddy in the centre.
- Ask the child to dress Teddy.
