More Simple Sentences Rhagor o Frawddegau Syml

Use the following vocabulary when discussing summer time activities and summer weather with the children. You may use the words incidentally throughout play and use one or two of the words in Welsh in the context of an English sentence if you do not feel confident using full Welsh sentences. The more of these words and phrases you use incidentally, the more children will hear the phonetic Welsh alphabet and use this to develop their linguistic skills through repetition. You may also use these words to create labels to place on wall displays or resources around your setting.
