

A Welsh dimension in the creative corner



To bring a Welsh dimension into the creative corner you can use resources you already have.

Why not draw/colour items that represent Wales such as a daffodil, leeks, a dragon or a rugby ball.

Full setting learning opportunities are always fun, how about creating a papier mâché daffodil to display on a 'Cynefin' board or all decorating a part of a dragon each.

Using paper shapes the children could design a new shawl for a Welsh lady or a Welsh man's waist coat.

Leek painting is a great sensory experience for children, they are able to visually explore a symbol of Wales, along with experience with touch and smell.

The paint brushes/colouring pencils/pens could be kept in red, white and green pots or containers.

Children could be able to design their own rugby ball or flag.
